B&B Water Project, Inc. (Utility), pursuant to 179 IAC 1-6-1, will file with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission a 30-Day Filing to increase their Miscellaneous Rates & Charges. These increases would affect customers in the areas noted below.

Miscellaneous Fees

- A. Tap Charge \$3,275.00
All users at the time of connection to the waterworks system shall pay a charge to cover the cost of excavating and tapping the main, furnishing and installing service pipe from the main to the lot line; furnishing and installing corporation and stop cocks; and furnishing and installing meter crock (if outside), yoke, and meter. The charge for a 5/8-inch meter tap shall be \$3,275.00. The charge for a tap larger than the 5/8-inch meter tap shall be the cost of labor, materials, power machinery, transportation, and overhead incurred for installing the tap, but shall be no less than the charge for a 5/8-inch meter tap.
- B. Collection and deferred payment charge 10% of first \$3.00 & 3% of excess.
All bills for water service not paid within seventeen (17) days from the due date thereof, as stated in such bills, shall be subject to the collection or deferred payment charge of ten percent (10%) on the first \$3.00 and three percent (3%) on the excess of over \$3.00.
- C. Disconnect or Reconnection charge \$75.00 per trip.
When the service is turned off for non-payment of a bill, or a customer requests the service to be disconnected or a meter turned off and locked, a charge of \$75.00 will be made by the Corporation to cover the cost of discontinuation. To reestablish or unlock a meter a charge of \$75.00 will be made by the Corporation to cover the cost of the continuance. The charges, together with any arrears due to the Corporation, shall be paid by the customer before service is re-established. This rate applies for normal working hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If the Customer requests a meter to be re-established outside of these hours during the weekday the fee shall be \$115.00. The fee will be \$150 for weekends and holidays.
- D. Transfer fee \$50.00
A customer is charged a fee when an existing meter is transferred from the former customer.
- E. General service charge \$75.00/\$115/\$150
This charge will be made for any trip to the member's premises at his request, (other than for a reconnection or initial connection to the waterworks system), for conditions on the member's service. The rate of \$75.00 applies for normal working hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If the Customer requests a trip outside of these hours during the weekday the fee shall be \$115.00. The fee will be \$150 for weekends and holidays.
- F. Membership fee \$150.00
- G. Minimum charge for connection Actual Cost,
but not less
than

- H. Charge for tampering with a meter or any of the Company's equipment Actual Cost,
but not less
than \$500.00
- I. Special reading of meter at customer's request \$75.00
- The rate of \$75.00 applies for normal working hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. If the Customer requests a trip outside of these hours during the weekday the fee shall be \$115.00. The fee will be \$150 for weekends and holidays.
- J. Non-Sufficient Funds fee \$30.00
- A fee of \$30.00 will be charged to a member for any form of payment that is returned for any reason. The fee along with any amounts due shall be paid by the customer to continue service.
- K. Credit & Debit Card Fee 3%
- If a customer elects to pay any outstanding balance using a credit or debit card a 3% service fee shall be added to the amount paid to recover amounts charged by the Servicing company to provide this service. This fee may be changed by the Corporation as conditions merit.
- L. ACH fee: .50 per transaction.
- If a customer elects to pay any outstanding balance using ACH a service fee of .50 per transaction shall be added to the amount paid to recover amounts charged by the Servicing company to provide this service. This fee may be changed by the Corporation as conditions merit.
