A Message to Our Customers

B&B Water Project wants to thank everyone who participated in the IURC withdrawal process, including those who attended the meeting and those who submitted absentee votes. We appreciate everyone who took the time to be involved.

Facts & Updates

- The monthly board meeting was held on May 19th, 2026, where April operations were reviewed.
- Water loss was at 31% in April, down 8% from the previous month. This is the lowest we have seen in a while.
- We are actively installing submeters throughout the system to detect potential leaks. These help us compare total water usage in an area to household usage and identify unaccounted for water loss.
- The results from the May 14th meeting regarding B&B Water Project's status with the IURC are **in favor of withdrawal from the IURC.**

Field Operations

- 9 meters replaced in April
- Routine maintenance included exercising 12 hydrants and 16 valves.

Recent work & Repairs:

- A submeter was placed on Hinkle Rd
- A leak was found and repaired on Bethel Ln
- A leak was found at a service tap and was repaired on State Rd 45
- 3 call outs in April

Office

Past Due Report:

- As of 4/17/26 there were 86 customers on the past due report, totaling \$12,224.76 owed. As of 4/29/2026 there were 13 customers left on the past due report, totaling \$3,398.90 owed.

Disconnect:

- There were 11 disconnects/reconnects in April. There were 2 remaining on the past due list that were already off and locked.
